

EXHIBIT INFORMATION

Entries must be in place between 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Monday, July 30. Work must never have been exhibited in this fair before. Entries are limited to two entries per class per exhibitor. All exhibits will be judged Tuesday morning at 9:30 a.m. Judging is closed to the public. All exhibits must be picked up on Monday, August 6 between 3:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. Exhibits may also be picked up on Saturday, August 4 between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. (no free admission granted to pick up exhibits). Exhibits not picked up during specified hours will forfeit any premium money. Every article or animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the Board of Directors. The association will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. Attendants must be with the livestock and other exhibits at all times. No premium or award will be given on any article not listed in this premium catalog. If the number of exhibits exceeds the amount of money allocated, then the premium money for each award will be lowered or eliminated. The Braxton County Fair reserves the right to dispose of spoiled exhibits (mold, rotting vegetables, etc.) If premium checks are not cashed within 60 days, premiums will be forfeited by that exhibitor for the next year in which exhibits are entered. One Best of Show, with a \$25 premium will be awarded for open class and FFA exhibits.

1 - 4-H

Closed Division, open to those youth enrolled in 4-H in Braxton County. Scoring will be based on a completed 4-H project including circular and record of activities. All projects scoring 90 and above will be rated blue ribbon projects, 80-89 red ribbon projects, and below 79 white ribbon projects. All blue ribbon projects will be given \$5.00; red ribbon projects will be given \$4.00; white ribbon projects will receive \$3.00. Premium monies will not be paid on livestock projects until books have been completed and scored. Best of Show, with a \$25 premium, will be awarded to one Junior and one Senior exhibit.

2 - Food Products

First place exhibit will receive \$5.00; second place will receive \$4.00; and third place will receive \$3.00. To cut down on waste, *except for decorated cakes which can be a smaller version*, exhibit ½ of a cake. Exhibit ½ loaf of bread in a plastic bag. Divisions A through C must be displayed in sealed containers or bags. Canned foods must have been canned after the previous Braxton County Fair. **Containers must be standard canning jars. Jar lids and rings must be intact and rust free.** All entries must be prepared by the exhibitor.
